WOMAN SETTLES CASE FOR \$82,500 AGAINST NEW YORK CITY TRANSIT AUTHORITY

A Transit Authority Executive Secretary settled her sexual harassment case on the eve of trial against the New York City Transit Authority.

In 1995-1996, she was subjected to repeated unwarranted and unwelcome comments and gestures of a sexual nature from her supervisor. Afraid to complain for fear of reprisals she was able to transfer to another division.

However in 2006 due to a re-organization within the Transit Authority he again became one of her Supervisors. He started making comments about her body, "I would like to make love to you", "I feel like pulling down my pants and making love to you."

This time she reported the inappropriate and illegal behavior. After a subsequent investigation, the Supervisor was terminated after it became clear that he had sexually harassed other female employees.

As it was clear in the lawsuit, TA Management knew or should have known of the Manager's inappropriate and illegal behavior towards female employees and failed to take any remedial action against the Manager.
